## **Green Building Design**

**Ein Vortrag von Patrick Bellew, Atelier Ten, London am 1. Dezember 2016 um 18:30 Uhr im Oskar von Miller Forum**

Founding director of Atelier Ten, Patrick Bellew is one of the UK's Royal Designers and a building environmental engineer with more than thirty years' experience in the design of high-performance buildings and systems. He works with architects to create "green" buildings and is committed to sustainable design within the built environment. The work of his practice, Atelier Ten, is rooted in vernacular design but extends through technology into modernity.

In this lecture Patrick Bellew will describe how the application of a broad range of environmental ideas has shaped his work by specific reference to recently completed green buildings – for example Gardens by the Bay in Singapore, one of their highlight projects. Here Atelier Ten provided mechanical and electrical engineering design to completion and masterplan sustainability consultancy, including environmental design consulting, building services design, daylight analysis, energy modeling and thermal modeling.
